In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Jesus' ascension into heaven is like the completion of a circle, one which began with his incarnation and is completed by his return to the Father.

The service includes three hymns: an opening hymn 214 - Hail the Day That Sees Him Rise; an offertory hymn 215 - See the Conqueror Mounts in Triumph; and a closing hymn 450 - All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name (vv. 1-3), played by Dr Michael Larkin, with lessons and prayers read by George McDowell and Lisa Bowe.
