

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- * If indoors, masks must be worn. We will provide masks for anyone who needs them.
- * You will be seated by one of the ushers when you arrive. The pews have been marked off to maintain safe social distancing.
- * Physical distancing must be adhered to while waiting to be seated. Members of the same family may sit together.
- * The Order of Service for that day, along with the readings and notices, will have been placed on the pews. Please use this during the service and take it with you when you leave.
- * Restrooms are closed except for emergencies.
- * The Lounge, Office and Great Hall will be closed.
- * There will be music but we will be unable to sing.
- * Offerings can be left in the collection plate.
- * Communion will be in one kind only. Communicants will line up before the altar to receive the host in the palm of their hand. The sacrament can be consumed once you are back in your seat.
- * In this warmer weather, members may wish to bring bottled water to the service.
- * Hand sanitizers will be available.
- * An online service will be provided for those who cannot attend.
- * A “virtual” coffee hour via Zoom will begin at 12:30 p.m.

All are invited, but we ask that all members, especially those with underlying health conditions, carefully assess the risk to themselves before attending.
